Christ is risen!

At Easter we celebrated the incredible news that Jesus Christ has risen from the dead. Death has lost its sting, do not be afraid.

It is difficult to imagine what it was like to be those followers of Jesus who heard the news and then met the risen Christ. In May, at St Mary's, we will hear again of those first encounters; meetings on the road, by the edge of the sea, eating together, being encouraged and challenged.

On the day that I write these notes the sun is blazing, grass is growing vigorously, flowers are blooming. It might be easy to imagine that all was bright and brilliant after the Resurrection. Life was not easy; the disciples were in hiding, there was no certainty for the future.

When Peter met the risen Christ he was transformed. Peter left behind the guilt of denying Jesus and took on the challenge that Jesus gave him: tend my sheep.

As we go about our daily tasks do what Jesus told Peter – tend my sheep, look after the people about you, bring good news and hope. Sometimes we might make mistakes: that is the risk we have to take.

We need to be aware of how God meets us in our everyday lives; through the caring of a doctor, at the sharing of a meal, in times of laughter with our friends, in the quiet of sadness. Especially in those times when we might feel lost or confused, that is when we need reassurance – Christ is with us, do not be afraid.

What do you want at your funeral?

It might seem a strange question but often when I've visited a bereaved family I've been told 'we don't know what Mum would have wanted'.

Making decisions about what to include in a funeral service can be difficult for a grieving family as they want to say their farewells and give thanks in a way that is appropriate.

Making plans doesn't mean we are about to die, just that we prepare our wishes in the same way as we write a will, so that things go as smoothly as possible.

It is good to talk to family and friends. Although a conversation may be difficult, it can prevent unhappiness and ill-feeling later on. When the time comes, those closest to you will be prepared and know that they are carrying out your wishes. If you do leave written instructions, ensure it is known where to find them.

It is helpful for family members to know if you wish for a cremation or burial and where the funeral could be held. If you wish to be cremated, where would you like your ashes to be placed?

At most services there are readings; you may have a favourite poem or a bible passage that is important to you. Music can play an important part in funerals; are there particular pieces which you would like included, or hymns which have particular meaning for you?

By taking the initiative and setting out what you want now, you can get on with living your life, knowing that when the time comes your loved ones will know what you wanted and be spared from having to make difficult decisions.

However, bear in mind that a funeral is above all an occasion for your family and friends to express their grief and celebrate your life, so don't feel you need to dictate every aspect.

I am happy to help with advice. If you would like to discuss this further please ring the parish office and they will make an appointment for you.

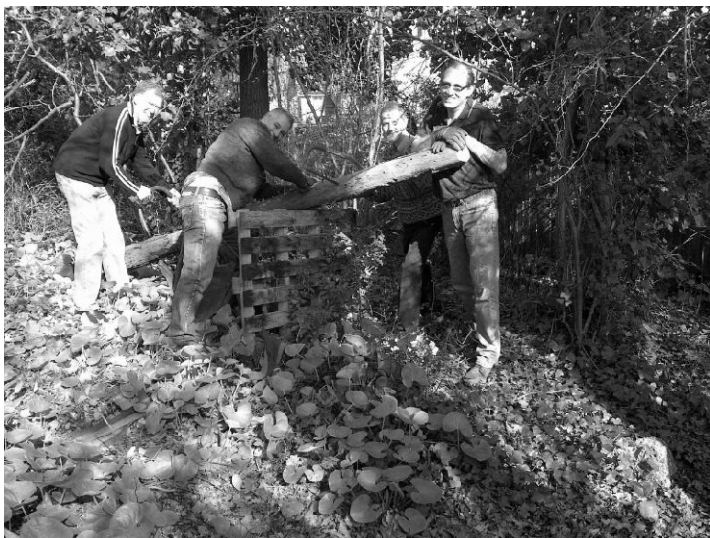

Prayer visiting in Shortlands

For the last six years, during the summer months, a small team of people from St Mary's has been visiting homes in the parish. Introductory letters are delivered in advance to a number of roads asking people if they have anything they would like the church to pray for. This is then followed up a few days later with a brief visit where the team collect any prayer requests and bring them back to the church for inclusion at Sunday services and daily prayers. The team has visited nearly every home in the parish; they are only unable to gain access to gated communities.

There is no praying on doorsteps or anything like that! The team goes out for an hour at a time, usually between 7 pm and 8 pm. Most visits last just a few minutes – some a little longer. Over the years there has been a huge response to the visits. The team hopes that their visits will remind people that St Mary's is there for everyone. Many conversations that start out 'oh, I'm not a church goer' or 'I don't believe any of that' end up with people asking for prayer for loved ones or difficult situations in their lives. Confidentiality is respected, and for many prayer requests only first names are used.

As Christians we believe in the power of prayer. It is our experience that prayer releases God's love into the world and into our lives. Perhaps one of our teams has visited you in the past, or will be knocking on your door this summer. If you don't share our belief in prayer, or if you don't want to share personal matters with us, then we won't bother you any longer than it takes to say 'No thank you'. Otherwise we look forward to seeing you either on the doorstep or at St Mary's.

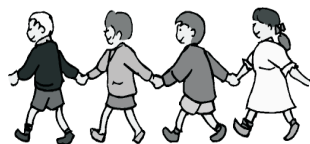
