Mission of the Month Special Baby Care Unit Princess Royal

The Special Care Baby Unit (SCBU) at the Princess Royal University Hospital, in Bromley, Kent, has run for many years. The majority of readers will have some reason to know of the SCBU. The Unit relies strongly on donations to allow them to purchase additional equipment, staff training, and facilities for the babies, their parents and families. The dedicated members of staff use their skills and knowledge to look after premature and sick newborn babies and their families.

Without these talented people and their equipment the babies would not be able to survive. The Unit has grown from 9 baby cots to 15 baby cots and is usually full. Donations are going towards purchasing specialised Apnoea monitors, which alert and record if a baby is experiencing breathing difficulties.

During the 10.30am service on Sunday, 17 June there will be a talk on the SCBU. Following this service refreshments, and cakes, will be available for which you can make a donation for this cause.
