went to school in that area and was a very bright pupil but in those days there were no opportunities for girls to go into further education and after leaving school aged 14 she worked in an office. That did not dim her thirst for knowledge and experience in life a curiosity and appetite which never left her.

In January 1940 she married Ernest. He went to war with the Air Force and she left London to spend the war years in Holdsworthy in North Devon and their daughter Jean was born there. In 1948 son John was added to the family.

Tragedy struck when Ernest was killed in a car accident, the children being only 17 and 10 years old.

Connie was a very artistic woman: she painted, loved her garden, arranged flowers to perfection, enjoyed collecting antiques, adored opera and ballet and was always interested in fashion. She was stalwart member of the congregation at St Mary's, at Durham House and a member of the 2WWs group, always interested in others.

The Committal at Beckenham Crematorium and Service of Thanksgiving at St. Mary's were both conducted by Rev Jane Peters. Connie will be remembered with much love and affection.

Care of Police Survivors (known as COPS) was founded in 2003 and is a UK registered charity dedicated to helping rebuild the lives of the families of police officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty. It aims to ensure that survivors have all the help they need to cope with such a tragedy, and that they remain part of the police family. Nobody understands the trauma of a line of duty death better than those who have endured it. COPS places new survivors in touch with those who are prepared to help others through the difficult times that lie ahead. COPS is run by survivors for survivors. Only another survivor can fully understand what new survivors endure, and that shared experience is the basis for the peer support programme. Membership is open to spouses, partners, children, parents and siblings of officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty.

COPS aims to build a network of survivors around the UK, developing the capability of having a local survivor as soon as required. Sometimes an understanding listener is needed. Sometimes more practical help is required. Whatever the need, COPS will be able to put survivors in touch with those who truly understand.


