#### My Day Job

I was born and brought up in South Africa. I left in 1987, sailed across the Atlantic on a yacht and ended up in London. For five years I was a media planner with a large advertising agency.

When my children were born I became actively involved in the National Childbirth Trust and the PTA.



When my children took up swimming with Beckenham Swimming Club, I became secretary of the club. I am an Honorary Life President of Beckenham Swimming Club, and a Past President of London Swimming and of Kent County Swimming. I am a British Swimming official and officiate at galas both locally and at a high level. I currently run the Arena Swimming League South, which is one of the biggest swimming leagues in the country.

My family has always been involved in the church. When I moved to Shortlands in 2014 I was delighted to be welcomed into the family at St Mary's and was a regular member of the Wednesday communion service. I like the simple Millennium chapel and the sense of community.

I travel a lot and I seek to worship wherever I can. The communion service is so entrenched in my life that I feel a kindred spirit with wherever I am visiting. One of the highlights of my recent travels was a trip I did with St Mary's to the Holy Land. I went as a pilgrim and came back as a disciple.

On Wednesday 11th March 2020 I flew to South Africa. A combination of travel restrictions and responsibility for an elderly relative in South Africa means that I have not returned to England. I have managed to worship here but lockdown has meant those opportunities have been few and far between. I wake up every day and praise God that I am healthy and not having to home school any children.

#### The taste of success



St Mary's first wine tasting since Covid started was held on Zoom, with over 40 people taking part.

Six wines (including a Malbec, a Pinot Noir and a Chenin Blanc) were decanted into 25cl bottles and delivered to all those taking part.

People tasted one wine at a time and then Tim and Andy from Refreshers in Shortlands Village each gave a review of the wine. Only one review was correct – participants had to work out which it was as well as completing two quizzes.

A great time was had by all and about £130 was raised for the Church organ fund.


## MISSION OF THE MONTH

In Kenya, extreme weather is making it harder and harder to survive.

Droughts are now more frequent

Droughts are now more frequent and more intense due to the climate crisis and, without reliable water



Drought forces people to walk further and further to collect water, and this daily burden robs them of the chance to farm and grow food. At 67 years of age, Rose walks for six hours a day to fetch water for her grandchildren. The jerry cans she carries hold 40 litres of water which weighs 40kg.

Your donation can help provide an earth dam for a community so, when the rains do come, water can be stored closer to people's homes. Just a simple earth dam could completely change the lives of Rose and many others.

During Christian Aid Week (10-16 May), we will again be delivering red Christian Aid envelopes to homes in Shortlands. #### **Ewan MacColl**

We've been featuring blue plaques commemorating notable people in our parish – we're now venturing just outside the parish boundary.

Ewan MacColl (1915-1989) is known to most people as a songwriter and singer. He was a committed socialist all his life and this underpinned all his creative



activities. His art reached huge numbers through the folk clubs, his recordings and the radio.

He was a member of the Young Communist League and was an activist in the unemployed workers' campaigns and the mass trespasses of the early 1930s. One of his best-known songs, 'The Manchester Rambler', was written after the pivotal mass trespass of Kinder Scout. He was responsible for publicity in the planning of the trespass.

In 1932 MI5 opened a file on MacColl, after local police asserted that he was 'a communist with very extreme views' who needed 'special attention'. For a time the Special Branch kept a watch on the Manchester home that he shared with his first wife, Joan Littlewood. MI5 caused some of MacColl's songs to be rejected by the BBC.

In 1957, while living in Stanley Avenue, he wrote 'The First Time Ever I Saw Your Face' for his then wife Peggy Seeger. This song became a No. 1 hit in 1972 when recorded by Roberta Flack and won MacColl a Grammy Award for Song of the Year.

He was married three times: to theatre director Joan Littlewood; to Jean Newlove, with whom he had a daughter, the singer/songwriter Kirsty MacColl; and to American folksinger Peggy Seeger.

The Blue Plaque is at 38 Stanley Avenue.
